The Herring Song 	<p>Activities</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Get to know the song. Listen to the song and join in when ready, Practise singing the song and learnt he words. Improvise a percussion accompaniment for Menu Song. Play percussion instruments to make and accompaniment to Menu Song. Listen to Herring Song. Prepare a dramatic performance for Menu Song. Practise Menu Song to the backing track. Select percussion instruments to play in the performance. Perform Menu Song. Warm up appropriately.
