Dear Parents/Carers,

We were pleased to welcome the children back to school following the Easter holiday and it has been lovely to see the children in their uniforms, focused and working hard.

Although the COVID-19 rates in Salford continue to reduce after the third wave, we all need to continue to do our bit to enable school to stay open and keep each other safe.

Our school COVID-19 Risk Assessment remains in place, and is reviewed regularly, however, advice to schools remains the same and all our protection measures continue to be in place.

This means that:

- All children continue to enter and leave their individual classes at specific times. Please ensure you continue to drop off and pick up your children at their correct times. This avoids congestion at the gate and on the school corridors
- Only one parent to accompany children to minimise the numbers of adults on school grounds
- Facemasks must be worn on the school site
- Socially distance on the playground at the beginning and end of the day
- The school play park is out of bounds
- Please leave the school grounds once you have collected your children

Please ensure your children are fully supervised at the beginning and end of the day. Children will only be supervised on entry to school. Before this time, they are your responsibility. Please avoid children jumping off the blue playground separators or the football nets. We want to avoid children having accidents and hurting themselves.
