Dear Parents and Carers,

FSM Vouchers over the Easter Period

Children in receipt of benefit based free school meals should receive an Aldi voucher for the two-week holiday - £30 per child. For most families, this will arrive in the post if you have completed a consent form or via collection from school. If you do not receive the voucher, please contact Spirit of Salford on 0800 952 1000.

School Uniform

Following the Easter break, all children must be back in full school uniform including appropriate school shoes as follows:

Uniform

Grey skirt / trousers / pinafore
White shirt or blouse
School tie – navy and green striped
Navy sweatshirt or cardigan with or without the Willow Tree logo

Summer Uniform

Summer dress green or blue only
Grey shorts

Shoes

Must be all black with no obvious branding or coloured soles. Any child wearing inappropriate shoes after the Easter break will be given a pair of black pumps to keep and wear in school and parents will be contacted.

We appreciate that school shoes can be expensive, please speak to Mr Thorpe if you are experiencing financial difficulties at the present time as we may be able to help you with this.

Jewellery

Children may wear a simple stud earring if they have their ears pierced
Children may wear a watch. This does not include smart or internet enabled watches

No other jewellery is permitted for health and safety reasons
