## November Update Letter

It has been lovely to welcome the children back into school after the half term holiday. As you may be aware, Salford has one of the highest rates of Coronavirus infection in the country and we all need to work hard to protect one and other and our school community.

From Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> November, we will enter a national lockdown. Schools will continue to open however, the key message is

**Remember your Hands, Face and Space and Stay at home, if you think you may have the virus.**

**If a member of your family bubble has symptoms and has booked a test, your children should not be in school until you have a negative result, if possible could you please email the Covid Test result to school.**

We must all do everything we can in the next four weeks of national lockdown to control the virus. Therefore, on school grounds you must:

- ***Supervise your children at all times***
- ***Children should be stood with their adult not playing together mixing bubbles on the playground***
- ***Wear a face covering at all times unless you are exempt***
- ***Only one adult to drop off or pick up children***
- ***The play park is not to be used before or after school***
- ***When lining up at classroom doors or on the playground you must be two metres apart from other families***
- ***KS2 will only be dismissed from their designated meeting point***
- ***Leave the school grounds as soon as you have collected your children and not congregate outside school***
- ***All Birthday treats will only be accepted if they are individually wrapped***
