School Uniform

Dear Parents/Carers,

Wearing the correct uniform is an essential part of being a pupil at Willow Tree Primary School.

The uniform policy has been fully agreed by the governing body.

There is an expectation that all children wear the correct school uniform and school shoes as follows:

- Grey skirt / trousers / pinafore
- Navy sweatshirt - with or without the Willow Tree logo
- White shirt or blouse
- School tie - navy and green striped

Black leggings and jeans are not part of school uniform and children will be challenged if they are wearing them.

Children are expected to wear appropriate shoes. Children not adhering to this policy will be given black pumps to change into.

One of the reasons for having the uniform policy is to ensure that no child feels left out or sidelined because they may not be able to afford the 'latest' shoes or clothing.

We understand that it can be expensive buying new black school shoes for rapidly growing feet. Therefore, as a school we agreed that black trainer type shoes can be worn.

In order to keep within the school uniform policy we have to insist that the trainers are black and do not have branding on them. An example is given below:
