

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are looking forward to welcoming you all back on Tuesday 7th September.

School opens at 8:45 when we will welcome children back into their classes. Please ensure children are supervised on the playground until this time. Children are welcome into school anytime from 8:45am until 9am. The school gates will close promptly at 9am, after this time children will be directed round to the main reception and given a late mark.

Over the summer holiday, work has begun on building the houses on the land opposite school. This means that the side roads opposite school are no longer available to park on. There is now very limited parking outside of school on Greenland Street. Wherever possible please walk to school. We are very concerned about the volume of traffic at the beginning and end of the day and walking to school wherever possible will help alleviate this problem.

Our school Covid-19 Risk Assessment has been updated and will be on the school website early next week.

The most important control measures we will continue to use in school are:

Hand hygiene. – Children will still be expected to sanitise on entry and exit to school and at other times throughout the day

We will continue to regularly clean down surfaces in school such as toilets and door handles and children's tables

Ventilation- we will continue to have the windows open in classrooms and in school. School will not be cold but it is important that all children have their jumpers or cardigans in school.

If your child is unwell and presenting with any of the three main symptoms of Coronavirus they must stay at home. (See below)

A high temperature.

A new continuous cough, this means coughing a lot for more than an hour or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours.

A loss or change to sense of smell or taste.

Please inform the school office on 921 2850 if your child is too unwell to attend school.

A reminder of the school uniform policy. **It is an expectation that all children wear the correct uniform and shoes. This is an important part of being a Willow Tree pupil.**

PE Kits

All children are expected to take part in PE and have the appropriate kit as follows:

- Black Pumps

(No Football shirts or Football T-shirts)

School Shoes

Children may wear trainer style shoes as long as they are completely black (no white or coloured soles) and do not have obvious branding on them –white or coloured stripes or ticks etc. School will provide black P.E pumps for any child not wearing the correct shoes.
