Our Learning this term

Read Write Inc. Phonics

This term, we will be continuing to learn our set 1 sounds.
We will continue to learn lots of songs and rhymes linked to our topic journeys and transportation.

Writing

This term, the children will continue to work towards developing a comfortable grip. They will be encouraged to 'mark make' with a purpose in mind e.g. writing their name, naming and writing some sounds and focusing on letter formation.

Our theme this half term:

Journeys and transportation

We will be looking at:

- Space
- Aeroplanes
- Boats and ships
- Trains and cars
- Emergency services
- Summer season

Our special books:

Whatever Next, Astrogirl, Emma Jane's Aeroplane, Lost and Found, The Train Ride, Who is Driving?, Emergency Rescue, let's go for a walk.

MATHS

In maths, we will be practising saying the numbers in order to make sure the children can recite numbers to 10 and beyond. We will explore the composition of numbers to 5 and beyond. We will be learning about the number line and what numbers come before / after.

We will be consolidating all we have learned in nursery, including positional language, 2D and 3D shapes and pattern.

OTHER LEARNING AND NEED TO KNOWS

We are now looking after some tiny caterpillars in nursery! We are watching them carefully to see how they grow and change. We are sure your child will keep you informed of their progress!
