Our Learning this term

Read, Write, Inc Phonics

This term, we will continue to work in small phonics group linked to our phonic scheme, Read, Write, Inc. The children will continue to recognise sounds speedily and use these to support their reading skills and writing. Phonics meeting for parents is on Friday 16th January 2026

Writing

Please continue to support your child to write and recognise their own name. Once they can write their first name, practise their surname. This term we want the children to start writing simple words and simple sentences on their own, using the sounds that they know.

MATHS

This term we are continuing to work with numbers up to 10 and how they can be split into 2 parts. We will be identifying equal and unequal sets of objects. We will be learning how to double numbers to 5 and how they are two equal groups.

Please continue to support your child to recognise numbers in the environment, look for shapes and patterns and count objects in everyday life.

Measurement

We will also be learning how to measure things, starting with weighing and exploring capacity. We will be using vocabulary that compares height and length and talking about the passing of time: days of the week, daily routines, morning, afternoon, evening and night.
