WRITING This term we are writing:

SCIENCE

This term we are learning about **Animals, including Humans.**

Our Key Knowledge is:

- Noticing that humans have offspring which grow into adults.
- Finding out about and describing the basic needs of humans, for survival
- Describing the importance for humans to exercise, eat the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

HISTORY

This term we are learning about **Remembrance** and **The Great Fire of London**

Our Key Knowledge is:

- Why people wear poppies.
- Why Remembrance Day is significant.
- What London was like before the fire.
- What happened during the Great Fire of London.
- Why the fire spread so quickly.
