WRITING This term we will be:

MATHS

This term we are focusing on division, length, mass and temperature.

SCIENCE

This term we are learning about **Living things and their habitats**

Our Key Knowledge is:

- Compare the difference between things that are living, dead and have never been alive
- Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants and how they depend on each other.
- Identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including micro-habitats.

Geography

This term we are learning about **Hot & Cold Places**

Our Key Knowledge is:

- Rainforests are found North and South of the equator.
- Hot deserts are found North and South of the Equator. They are very dry.
- The North and South Poles are the coldest places on the planet.
- Antarctica is very cold, with snow and ice covering much of the area.
