#### Our Learning this term

#### **WRITING**

This term we are using the text **Coming** to England by Floella Benjamin.

We are writing letters from Floella to her Grandmother telling her about settling into life in the UK.

#### **MATHS**

This term we are focusing on:

Numbers to 1,000 and addition and subtraction.

#### **SCIENCE**

This term we are learning about **ROCKS** 

Our 'Key Knowledge is:

- Classifying and sorting different types of rocks
- Learning how fossils are formed
- Understanding the differences between types of soil

#### **HISTORY**

Our Key Knowledge is:

#### OTHER SUBJECTS LEARNING AND KEY KNOWLEDGE

#### Reading

Year 3 children should be encouraged to read regularly at home. (4 times for 20 minutes a week is a good start).

#### **Home Learning**
